Extra Curricular Guidelines – CODE OF CONDUCT**

Philosophy

Extra Curricular activities are an integral part of the education of students at Chief Kanim Middle School. We believe extra curricular activities enhance the educational development of our students. The participants, coaches, and instructors in the extra curricular programs are under the jurisdiction of the school district, the Board of Directors, and are subject to all policies, rules, and regulations of the Snoqualmie Valley School District and the State of Washington. The extra curricular staff of Chief Kanim Middle School is committed to creating a positive experience for participants which will enable each participant to achieve their potential. We will actively promote the following goals through the Chief Kanim Middle School extra curricular program:

1. Promote the growth and development of Chief Kanim Middle School students.
2. Foster the development of good sportsmanship, teamwork, and positive self-worth.
3. Provide a challenging and satisfying experience for Chief Kanim Middle School students.

School Conduct

A student participant shall be a good citizen in school at all times. Disruptive behavior, defiance, persistent tardiness, truancy, and other violations of school rules are unacceptable. A student participant must realize that his/her primary purpose in attending school is to acquire an education. Therefore, any conduct that is detrimental to this purpose is unacceptable.

Attendance

A student participant must be in attendance at least one half of the school day (3 periods) to be eligible to participate in practice or games. Emergency circumstance may be arranged with the administration and/or coach.

Sanctions Regarding Academic Deficiency

The dedicated student gives 100% in everything. A student participant must keep up with his/her class assignments, have an attitude acceptable to the classroom teacher, and maintain an excellent record of attendance. Participants must maintain passing grades in all classes in order to participate, at or better than 60% in all classes.

Academic Eligibility Check

Every two weeks, teachers will complete Extra Curricular Eligibility checks. If a student participant is failing one or more classes, he/she will be placed on academic probation. When a student is placed on probation:

1. The student IS eligible to practice.
2. The student may NOT play in any sports games or drama productions.
3. The student may NOT dress in uniform/costume for any activity.
4. Parents will be notified.
5. Students will complete Progress Reports (weekly or as determined by the activity director and/or administration).
6. The probation period will end when the student is passing all classes. Eligibility will be reinstated at that time.

Sanctions Regarding Behavior Deficiency

Any student participant serving In-School suspension will not be permitted to participate in activities, including sports and drama practice and/or performances.
