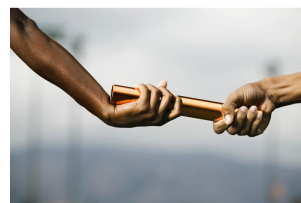

Online Payments Now Available for Student Meals

Adding money to your child's lunch account at any Snoqualmie Valley public school is now more convenient with online payments. The district has contracted with [RevTrak](#), a national credit card payment processor, to provide parents a secure site for making online payments.



Starting Monday, May 3 after 9 a.m., parents will be able to pay student food service fees, view account balances, and see their transaction history online. Online payments will immediately be posted to a student's food service account. Parents who chose this option will be charged a \$1.50 service fee.

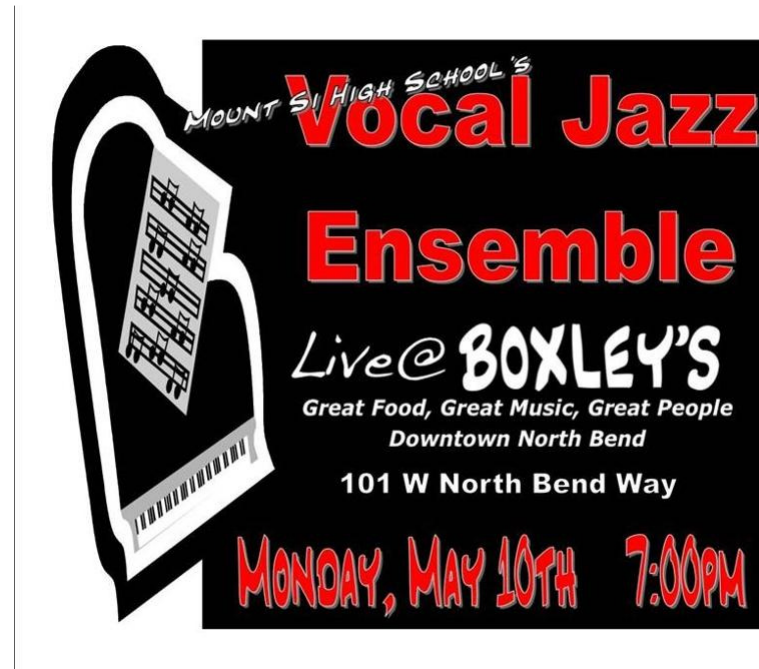
To access the convenience of making an online payment, you simply need:

- A VISA or MasterCard debit or credit card
- And, a Skyward Family Access Login and Password (Parent/guardians, if you've forgotten your Family Access login or password, please contact your school's office.)

Register for Summer School

The Snoqualmie Valley School District's 2010 Extended Learning Summer School program is offering classes for students at all grade levels from July 12-29, 2010 (Mondays through Thursdays). Like last year, classes during this three-week program will run during two sessions: at 8:00 -10:30 am, and at 10:45 am - 1:15 pm. The cost of each class is \$215. Scholarship support (discounted tuition) is available for those who qualify for the federal free or reduced meal program. The deadline for Summer School registration and payment is **July 9**.

Web Academy online courses will also be offered for high school credit from June 28-August 6. Each six-week course costs \$215 per subject. The deadline for Web Academy registration and payment is **June 30**.

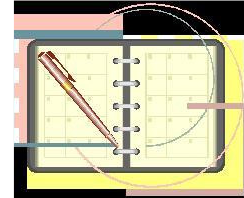
