With the end of the school year fast approaching, your school nurse would like to remind those parents with medications at school for your child to make sure that these medications are picked up and taken home. Any medication left by the end of the day on June 17th, will be destroyed.

If your child requires medications to be given at school next fall, please remember that **new parent permission slips** and **physician's orders** must be received before any medications can be given. You can download the forms from the District website or pick them up at your school.

If your child has an Individual Health Care Plan on file at school, the school nurse will be contacting you about any changes in your child's health conditions or medications prior to the end of June or the beginning of the new school year. Please make sure to update any information that is necessary.

College Bound Scholarships

Think you can't afford college? Think again.

College Bound Scholarships provide hope and incentive for students and families who otherwise might not consider college as an option because of its cost.

To qualify, low-income 7th and 8th grade students who sign a pledge **by June 30 of their 8th grade year** are eligible. Eligible students promise to graduate from a Washington high school with at least a 2.0 GPA, demonstrate good citizenship, and seek admission to a college or university. Family income eligibility will be re-checked and college admission confirmed after the student graduates from high school. Foster youth are automatically eligible to apply.

The amount of the scholarship, awarded through the Washington Higher Education Coordinating Board, will be based on tuition rates at Washington public colleges and universities. It will cover the amount of tuition and fees (plus \$500 for books) not covered by other state financial aid awards!

The Snoqualmie Valley School District's 2010 Extended Learning Summer School program is offering classes for students at all grade levels from July 12-29, 2010 (Mondays through Thursdays). Like last year, classes during this three-week program will run during two sessions: at 8:00 -10:30 am, and at 10:45 am - 1:15 pm. The cost of each class is \$215. Scholarship support (discounted tuition) is available for those who qualify for the federal free or reduced meal program. The deadline for Summer School registration and payment is **July 9**.

Web Academy online courses will also be offered for high school credit from June 28-August 6. Each six-week course costs \$215 per subject. The deadline for Web Academy registration and payment is **June 30**.
