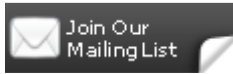
Stay in the Know!

The deadline to register for the next King County election is Monday, January 10.

Simply go online to... www.vote.wa.gov.

- Check your status by clicking on "MyVote."
- Registration forms must be postmarked 29 days prior to an election.
 - You can change an address to your current King County registration by calling the King County Elections Office at 206-296-VOTE (206-296-8683).
 - Those new to King County can register online in advance, or register in-person up to 8 days before an election at the King County Elections Office.
