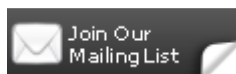

This meeting is for parents only. Students will visit at another time.

HI-C Language Arts: At CKMS 6th, 7th and 8th grade students are placed in grade level Language Arts classes covering the same material. Students choosing to be in HI-C may be given a different form of the assignment evaluated with a HI C rubric. The HI-C assignments and rubric will be explained at Open House by the Language Arts teacher.

6th grade Math Placement: At the beginning of the school year all 6th grade students will be put in average math classes. During the first week of school, they will take a math placement test. Teachers will then compile the following Criteria for each student which consists of: Spring MSP test score, Spring 5th grade math assessment score, 5th grade COGAT Quantitative Score, & 6th grade Fall placement test score. Total point from tests will be reviewed and placement will be made. CKMS will have two advanced 6th grade classes. For students that are coming from out of district or out of state, we will review data they enter CKMS with.
