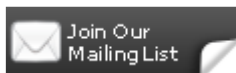

ROAD CLOSURES

Transportation Notice to Fall City Families:

Our school district has been notified by the Department of Transportation that they are planning to close one lane on SR 202 at Tokul Creek, between Fall City and Snoqualmie, for up to four weeks for construction. Starting Friday, September 3, the lane will be closed for up to 18 hours per day, including during peak commute times.

This will not require any changes to Fall City school bus routes or pick-up locations; however, it may result in delays while flaggers alternate traffic around the closure. Crews will be fixing a problem under the bridge, in which Tokul Creek is eroding the hillside near the bridge abutments.
