Early Release Friday update

We would like to take this opportunity to update you on the quality and quantity of work that has been accomplished so far this school year during our early release time each Friday afternoon. This time is divided into three categories:

Teacher directed days - this time is used by individual teachers and grade level teams to plan lessons, prepare materials, work in grade level teams to coordinate curriculum and to catch up with correspondence to and from parents.

Building directed days - we have been focusing this time with the implementation of our school improvement plan. Math intervention GLAD strategies have been studied, Science lesson development, review and modify grade level action plans and learning about the social media effect on the educational process.

District directed days - grade level teams have worked on math, science and transitions so far this school year.

These early release days have been crucial in keeping the focus on student learning and allowing our staff to collaborate and plan detailed lessons associated with our school improvement planning process.
